### Allegheny Park — 810 Arch St, Pittsburgh, PA 15212

Established in 1867, Allegheny Commons is Pittsburgh's oldest park. Known for its mature canopy trees, wide promenade, and lovely Lake Elizabeth, Allegheny Commons is the front yard for the Northside's diverse neighborhoods. Get ready for some exciting activities to help teach you more about the history of the park and find some of its hidden treasures.

- What is the name of the lake in the middle of Allegheny Park? **10**
- Gus and Yiayia's is a historic shaved ice stand in Pittsburgh Allegheny Commons Park. Submit a picture of the shaved ice stand. **13**
- An American Civil War Memorial stands tall in the Allegheny Commons Park to commemorate those who served in the Union and gave their lives in the American Civil War, what is the name of the memorial? **15**
- Situated 630 feet southeast of the Allegheny Commons is one of our very own YMCA branches – the Allegheny YMCA. Upload a photo spelling out YMCA! **13**
- What is the name of the fountain that sits in Allegheny Commons Park? **12**
- The YMCA holds a summer day camp program at the Allegheny Y, tell your kids what was your favorite activity to do as a child, enter your answer. **8**
- How many windows face the park from the Allegheny YMCA across the street on West North Ave.? **13**
- How many steps are on the slide at the playground? **10**
- Build a small boat out of anything you can find in the park and test to see if it floats in the pond. Take a picture of your boat **15**
- How many steps does it take to get across the bridge in the park? **12**
- It goes over the pond, and connects people from one side to the other. From a view up here, you can see what's below in the water. **8**
- Kids love me and have so much fun here, there is a path you have to take to get there. There is a slide and monkey bars, and from here you can see moving cars. **8**
- Across from the park is the national aviary. Home to many species of birds. Send a video of you waddling like the African penguins, or flapping your arms and soaring like the bald eagles that live there. **12**
