## Settlers Cabin Park

### HOW TO PLAY:

Take your scavenger hunt sheet to the following park and complete each activity. You can complete on your phone while you are at the park at [pittsburghymca.org/scavengerhunt](http://pittsburghymca.org/scavengerhunt) hunt, or upload your photos and complete any remaining questions when you get home!

### Settlers Cabin Park – 608 Ridge Rd, Pittsburgh, PA 15205

At 1589 acres, this park was intended to be the largest of the regional parks, and still has a wild, rugged, and unexplored quality not found in the other parks. Bringing your hiking boots and find some hidden treasures throughout all acres of this scenic park!

- Find the entrance to the Green Trail at Settlers Cabin Park. If you hike a half mile down the trail, what unique natural feature can you find? **10pt**  
**Bonus Point** Post on Facebook a picture of someone under it! And TAG **#YMCAPghHunt 15pt**
- There are chimney looking structures spread throughout the park. These are habitats for a certain kind of bird? What is the type of bird and can you take a picture in front of the tower? **13pt**
- Are you a day camp family? Find the "Dragon's Lair" and take a picture. **10pt**
- In 2015 the park became more accessible via a connector trail to the \_\_\_\_\_ Trail which is a 29-mile stretch from Carnegie to Weriton, WV as well as the Montour Trail. Find this location, make silly faces and share a photo. **15pt**
- Off of Ridge road is a great place to play a game that was founded by the YMCA. Stop here for a short game with your family. What is the name of the game? **9pt**
- Take your dog to the dog park and take a little video of them doing a trick. If you don't have a dog take one of someone else's dog share video. **22pt**
- Stop in-front of Settlers Cabin Park sign and build a pyramid with your family and take a picture with the sign in it. **15pt**
- Using only materials you find around the park, Build a shelter that one person in your family can fit in and post the picture of them in it. **22pt**
- How many pavilions are located in Settlers cabin park? **8pt**
- Did you know that the YMCA holds a summer day camp program at Settlers Cabin each summer? We are located at 2 shelters right next to each other. One is called Chippewa, what is the name of the other shelter? **10pt**
- Find the Walker Log Cabin and take a photo of you at the front door. **25pt**  
**Bonus Points** Find the Storybook Cabin and tell your kids a story from your past. Post pictures of you in Adirondack chairs. (Hint it is close but not on Settlers cabin property). **36pt**
